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Top to Bottom: A Hudson River Arts Map Installation June 13-August 9, 2009 - Curator: William Hochhausen

CALL FOR ARTISTS

The Edward Hopper House Art Center, birthplace and childhood home of renowned artist Edward Hopper, welcomes applicants from communities along the Hudson River for the exhibition *Top to Bottom: A Hudson River Arts Map Installation*. The exhibition is open to work in all media that has been inspired by the Hudson River, including drawing, painting, photography, prints, mixed media, collage, wall relief, digital art, video, and sculpture. Sculpture must not exceed 50 lbs., flatwork must not exceed 30" including frame; wall relief limited to 6" in depth. The curator's objective is to organize work by region and thereby create an art *map* of Hudson River creativity. The gallery will be reshaped to accommodate the variety of work selected, a true "installation". This exhibition is part of a series of historic, community-wide events celebrating the Hudson-Fulton-Champlain Quadracentennial (see exploreny400.com).

Submissions: Interested artists should send a brief bio and artist's statement along with one image for consideration on CD, a \$15 nonrefundable entry fee, and a SASE

for the return of the CD. Entries on CD must be in Jpeg format only and no less than 280 dpi. CD must be labeled with artist's name, title of work, size, and medium, listed in order.

Deadline: Entries must be received by **March 20, 2009**.

Selection & notification: Selections will be made by the by the Gallery Selection Committee and artists will be notified by April 6, 2009.

Delivery/installation: Work may be delivered on: Sunday, June 7: 4-7 pm; Monday June 8: 10-3 pm. Artwork must arrive ready to hang with eye-hooks on the back. Artists are responsible for shipping/delivery. Instructions will be included with acceptance letters.

Contract: Accepted artists must contract with Hopper House agreeing to exhibition terms including, but not limited to, installation schedule and liability waiver. The Hopper House shall receive 35% commission on any art sold from the premises.
